



We believe that families and children are a gift from God and we are committed to partnering with parents as we encourage and teach our kids to be followers of Jesus.

Here is how we can partner together...

Information Card: An information card must be filled out on all children by a parent/guardian. Please include any medical need that we need to be aware of and who is authorized to pick up your child. Include special instructions like teething, potty training, allergies, special needs, etc. This helps us provide a safe and loving environment for our children.

Class Time: Children's Ministry takes place from 10:15 to 11:30 am. We allow families a 15-minute buffer after service begins for late arrivals. Because we are a portable church, we need to break down after every service. We encourage parents to pick up their children as soon as possible after service. We also understand that parents need ministry and we are flexible if we need to be in order for you to receive what God has for you today.

Check In / Out: For the safety of your child, only those listed on your information card can pick up your child. For simplicity, we ask that the same parent who checks in also pick up. If you are late picking up your child, we may bring your child to you as we are on a time schedule to pack up Children's Ministry after service ends.

Serving: Parents/guardians are expected to serve once a quarter in Children's Ministry. Our Children's Ministry depends of volunteer support ranging from greeting children as they arrive, providing child care at our midweek service and Bible studies, assisting teachers in class, overseeing our children before Children's Ministry begins or helping with set up and tear down. Please inform the Children's Director as to how you would like to serve.

Personal Items: Please leave your child's favorite toys at home. We can't be responsible for lost items. Please label your child's belongings (even if they are in a diaper bag.) A favorite blanket to comfort your child is okay to bring.

Health: Please do not bring your child to Children's Ministry if they are sick. We will always pray for your child, but we want to provide a healthy environment for all our kids. Do not bring medications to children's ministry workers to administer. We are not equipped to administer medication to your child.
